
### **Care and Maintenance**




Ensure the chair is not pushed against walls, door frames, cupboards or beds as this will cause damage to the frame.



Before removing the plastic seat, secure all four castors to help prevent the chair moving away from you.



Be careful when fastening the seat clips to the front frame, as the frame will scratch if the bar is forced between the clips and the metal runners on the underside of the seat.



If any part of the chair is damaged during use replacement parts are available.

## Cleaning



Remove the seat cushion, wipe it over, dry and place on a clean work surface.



Unclip commode seat from the chair frame, place in sluiceroom sink and clean thoroughly to remove faecal contamination.



Make certain that all parts of the chair are thoroughly dried after cleaning.



Re-assemble the commode after cleaning and use Vernaclean indicator to show the chair is clean.
